### **Scene 2: The Castle**

Jonathan:

30th October 1842. At last, I am here at Dracula's castle! What a strange journey. Let me explain. My name is Jonathan Harker. I am a lawyer and I live in London, England. I am here on business. I have business with Count Dracula. Count Dracula has bought a house. He has bought a house in London and I have some documents for him to sign. I don't





really want to be here but Mina told me to come. Mina is my girlfriend. Mina said "The Count is a very rich man and you can do lots of business with him." Mina is very clever. Mina and I are going to get married. We are going to get married when I return to London. I want to return soon. This place is strange. I hear wolves howling and people talk about vampires! How silly! Come on, let's get these papers signed! I hope the Count is at home. I'll knock on the door. (*Dracula appears*)

Hello...How do you do...I'm Jonathan Harker...from London...I think you are expecting me...I'm here on business...my company sent me...you have to sign some papers.

## Song 2: Sweet Vampire

### DRACULA:

How do you do...I'm pleased it's you... I hope your journey was pleasant.

Come into my house...Don't be a little mouse... Did you bring me a present?

Don't be shocked by the way I look... I only like to follow fashion...

And I'm so full of passion.

(Chorus)

I'm just a sweet blood-sucking, vampire from Transylvania.

Give me your case....Take a look at the place...Don't leave this room at night time.

If you do....What will happen to you? Horror, terror and fright time.

## JONATHAN:

Thank you, dear Count...I won't go out...I'll spend the whole night sleeping.

Now I'm here...I have no fear...it won't be me that is creeping.

### DRACULA:

I like your style...let's talk for a while....and then we'll have some dinner. (Chorus x2)

### JONATHAN:

I'd like to shave...and then perhaps bathe...the journey was really tiring.

### DRACULA:

Of course, my dear John let me finish this song... I find you oh, so inspiring! (Chorus x2)

Dracula: Please make yourself comfortable. My house is your house.

Jonathan: Thank you Count, you are very kind.

Dracula: Are you hungry? Would you like some dinner?





Jonathan: No, thank you, I had dinner on the train.

Dracula: Oh, but you will have some wine?

Jonathan: No, thank you, I never drink wine.

Dracula: Me neither. Now, sit down and tell me all about your beautiful city of London.

Jonathan: Well, London is a very big city with many beautiful buildings and lots of people and it

rains a lot!

Dracula: Ah! I like the rain and the mist and the fog and the dark. What about my new house? Tell

me about my new house.

Jonathan: It is a magnificent house. It has seven bedrooms, three bathrooms, a large kitchen, a

library, a big dining room and an enormous living room and it has a beautiful garden. I hope you like it! There is only one problem. It is next to a cemetery and it is very old.

Dracula: Perfect! I am also very old and I like to be near the dead! And I like the rain and the mist

and the fog and the dark. Now, let's do business and sign these papers.

Jonathan: Yes, of course. (He takes some papers out). Sign here and here and here. Good.

Congratulations Count. You now have a magnificent house in London. (Dracula sees a photo in his case). Ah! That is a photo of Mina. She is my girlfriend. We are to be married

as soon as I return to London.

Dracula: You are a very lucky man. She is very pretty and very young and very full of blood, I mean

life, full of life. Blood is the life! Without blood there is no life! Ha, Ha! Here take your photo of Mina and write a letter saying that you will stay here with me for one month.

Jonathan: One month! I would like to return as soon as possible. I am to be married. Mina is waiting

for me.

Dracula: Mina can wait! You will stay here with me for one month and I won't take "no" for an

answer. Now write! (*I writes and D dictates*) "Dear Mina. I will stay with the Count for one month. Do not worry, I am well. The Count is a very nice man and he's handsome, too and he wears nice clothes and he has a great playlist. I wish I were more like him, love

Jonathan."

Jonathan: Yes, I would like to shower and shave. I have my things here, my razor and my mirror.

Dracula: Let me help you. You might cut yourself and we don't want blood all over the floor, do we?

(Dracula shaves Jonathan. Jonathan looks in the mirror).

Jonathan: Oh! How strange! I can't see you in the mirror. You have no reflection!

Dracula: Don't worry, you don't need the mirror. Let us continue, you are only half shaved (Dracula

touches Jonathan's crucifix). Aaaah! Do not wear that in this house, you do not need it. Now, a little advice. Do not leave this room at night. This is not England, this is





Transylvania, and our customs are not your customs. Things are different here. Do you

understand?

Jonathan: Yes, I understand. I see and hear many strange things here. People that talk about

Vampires, wolves that howl in the night, mirrors with no reflection. I will not leave this

room at night. Don't worry!

Dracula: Good night.

Jonathan: Good night.

Dracula: Sleep tight.

Dracula: Don't let the bedbugs bite! (Exit Dracula).

Jonathan wakes up).

Dracula: Yes, yes that's enough. Now, I have to go away for a few days. You will stay here and my

servants will look after you. You can practice your dancing and singing if you like! Here is my playlist for you to listen to. (*Jonathan puts headphones on.*) Goodbye Jonathan...and remember do not leave this room...no matter how bored you are, do not leave...your life is in danger! (*He takes the photo of Mina*). There is someone I must visit! Ha...ha...ha... Be a

good boy! Ha...ha...ha.

Jonathan: Oh no! Now I have to stay here for days, listening to Dracula's heavy metal songs. If only I

had some Ariana Grande or Little Mix to listen to. Well, at least I have my picture of Mina to look at. (*He realises it has gone*). He's taken my photo of Mina! Why? Oh No! He must be in love with her. He must have gone to London to find her. I have to return to Mina. I have to get back to London and save her from the Count... I must escape... Help! Let me

out. Help!

## Scene 3: London Street in 1842

Mina: (She has Jonathan's letter and is reading it). Thank goodness, Jonathan

me at last, but it is a very strange letter. It is a very strange letter indeed. like Jonathan, at all. Let me see... (reading) "Dear Mina. I will stay with the Count for one month." One month is a very long time. He only went for a few days! "Do not worry. I am well. The Count is a very nice man and he's handsome too, and wears great clothes." I think I'd like to meet this Count, so handsome and fashionable! "And he has a great collection of opera CD's." But Jonathan doesn't like opera, he just likes Justin Bieber. "I wish I was more like him, love Jonathan. Kiss, kiss, kiss." Jonathan did not write this letter, I am sure of that. I am very







worried and feel that something terrible may have happened to him. I want him to come back soon, and then we can be married.

### (Enter Dracula).

Dracula: Good day, young lady.

Mina: Good day, sir.

Dracula: Excuse me, but I am looking for the museum, the British

Museum. I hear it is wonderful. Do you know where it is?

Mina: The British Museum? Of course, every Londoner knows where

it is. Why don't you buy a map? Buy a map instead of bothering

young ladies on the street?

Dracula: Forgive me, but I am a foreigner and do not know your customs or culture.

Mina: Oh, a foreigner! Well, if you want culture, sir, then it is a very good idea to visit the British

museum. The British museum is full of British culture and British customs! Good day to

you, sir.

Dracula: I am sorry. I have offended you. Good day.

Mina: No sir, forgive me. I am rude and I have offended you. I am sorry it's just that I have

received some bad news and I am sad. You see, I'm not accustomed to talking to strange

men in the street. Usually, I am with my boyfriend, but he...

Dracula: Yes? Where is your boyfriend? How can he let a beautiful woman like you walk alone on

the dangerous streets of London?

Mina: He is in Transylvania. He has travelled to Transylvania to do business with a Count.

Dracula: What a coincidence! I am from Transylvania. Let me introduce myself. I am Prince Vlad.

Mina: Goodness! A prince!

Dracula: And I am your humble servant, Madam...?

Mina: Miss. Miss Mina Murray, at your service, Prince. Please let me compensate for my bad

manners by showing you around the British Museum. There are so many things to see and

I'm sure you will like it. I can be your guide.

Dracula: How nice and such a pretty guide. Your boyfriend is a very lucky man.

Mina: Yes, but I am worried about him. He has written me a very strange letter and I think he

may be in danger.

Dracula: In danger! Why?

Mina: Well, his letter is very short and he has met a very strange man who he seems to like a lot.





Dracula: Let me see. (He reads the letter). I travel a lot and meet a lot of very strange people. I am

sure he is ok. I'm sure he is having a good time. You know what business trips are like; lots of work with no time to write long letters to your girlfriend. Don't worry; let's not think about him now. Now you are my guide and you will show me London, you are here with

me and that is what is important. I am sure we will become great friends... Mina.

Mina: Yes, it's strange. I feel that I know you.

Dracula: You do know me Mina. You know me very well.

They sleep in the day and hunt at night. They live in hot places and they live cold places. They live in trees, under leaves, hanging from branches, under bridges and in caves. They eat flowers, fish, meat and they drink blood. Bats are mammals. Bats have arms, hands and feet. They have fur or hair. Bats are soft and smooth and they feel nice.

(Enter Dracula & Mina).

Mina: Oh, thank you. (She drinks). Mmmmm! It's delicious! What is it?

Dracula: Blood-red strawberry juice.





Mina: Mmmm! Is there any more?

Dracula: Well, yes, but you'll have to wait until later. Now I want to show you my Spotify playlist.

Mina: Oh great! I love music especially Beyonce. What have you got?

Dracula: Well, I've got this...(heavy metal)...or I've got this (heavy metal)...or I've got this (heavy

metal)...

Mina: Have you only got heavy metal songs? They're not very romantic.

Draeula: Romantie?

Jonathan: In 1822?

Jonathan: A werewolf!?

Van Helsing: Yes, a werewolf, el hombre lobo. The werewolf attacked me when...

Jonathan: Attacked you!

Van Helsing: Yes, attacked me and don't interrupt me again! It attacked me and I jumped into action.

Jonathan: What did you do?

Van Helsing: There are many ways to kill the beasts of the night, werewolves or vampires. A stake

through the heart, garlic, crucifixes, by cutting off his head. But the easiest way is with

this. (He takes out a CD).

Jonathan: What's that?

Van Helsing: "Swish Swish" by Katy Perry. The most powerful weapon of destruction known to man...

and woman. Put it on and in seconds everyone is dancing the most ridiculous dance known to man...and woman. They dance and dance until exhausted and then drop down

powerless!

Dracula: It is too late Doctor, she is mine.

Jonathan: No, Mina! Have you drunk his blood?

Mina: His blood! Don't be ridiculous! Why would I drink his blood?

Jonathan: Then what is that?

Mina: It's just strawberry juice and it's lovely. Here taste some, Jonathan.

Jonathan: Oh, ok. (He drinks).

Van Helsing: No, Jonathan, no!

Jonathan: Mmm! It's lovely.
